Project Update

SR 89A, Vista

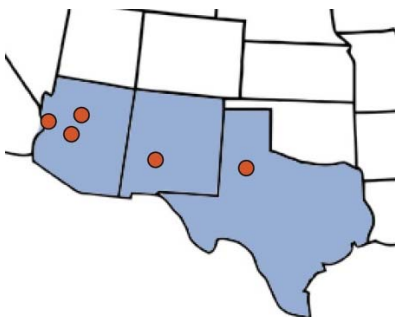
FNF has begun construction in March on State Route 89A just south of Flagstaff, AZ to widen and rehabilitate this critical route between Sedona and Flagstaff. The work consists of moving 200,000 CY of dirt and placing nearly 80,000 tons of AC. In an effort to complete the work safely and efficiently, FNF has worked with FHWA Central Federal Lands Division, ADOT, and the local community to close the roadway at night to traffic.
